In this age-old battle between Light and Darkness, we enter as messengers of hope, strengthened by God's repeated encouragement to Joshua as he prepares to enter the promised land, "to be strong and courageous!"

WHO ARE WE?

There are more than 17,000 people groups globally who have yet to encounter the message of Jesus Christ. **Our vision** is to develop and activate organic discipleship movements, rooted in local communities to share the gospel and empower individuals in their faith. Much like grass that emerges from the ground and spreads, the term 'grassroots' represents our belief that disciples and churches will naturally flourish and extend.

Our mission is to equip and send small, specialized teams to the least reached people groups, remote areas and vulnerable communities. These teams will serve as catalysts, igniting grassroots movements, providing discipleship, offering skills training, and initiating community development projects in unreached regions.

Our aim is to share the Message of Jesus Christ with 30 unreached people groups within the next 10 years. To achieve this, we intend to create special teams called "catalyst teams" in the areas where these unreached groups live. These catalysts will help initiate grassroots movements to introduce Jesus to these communities. BY 2033

HOW WILL WE ACHIEVE THIS VISION?

We trust God to accomplish His will through us as we focus on the following:



Mobilize and Equip Believers

We mobilize and train churches, professionals and organizations to passionately and effectively live and spread the gospel, locally and cross-culturally.

Train and Send Catalyst Teams



We strengthen individuals through discipleship, internships, leadership development, and skills training. Our focus is on transferring knowledge and skills while keeping our strategies simple and minimizing the need for extensive physical or technological infrastructure. Catalyst teams are sent out to develop and activate grassroots and organic discipleship movements.



Community Transformation

We holistically improve the well-being of people and communities spiritually, socially, emotionally and physically. We focus on education, agriculture, evangelism, discipleship and small business.



Prayer Initiatives

We organize, participate and engage in prayer initiatives to see His glory revealed and His Kingdom established in all the earth.

OUR MOTIVATION

Despite Jesus' command over 2,000 years ago to make disciples of all nations, 17,000 unreached people groups still exist. As believers, our role in the great commission is clear. Therefore, we, as Ethnos, aim to empower believers by providing access, training, and a platform for meaningful engagement in spreading the gospel. We believe every believer is called to participate, not just a selected few. Together, we can ensure everyone is reached.

OLYA'S STORY

In 2022, when the full-scale war began in Ukraine, my whole life was turned upside down. I had only one



question for God: "How, where, and what can I do to serve my people?" There were many options, but I wanted to hear His "calling" clearly. One day, our pastor suggested that we start serving the Internally Displaced People (IDPs) who had evacuated to our city.

We started providing humanitarian aid and communicating with the IDPs in the church, helping 300 people daily. It was here that we learned to listen, love and hug everyone. Later, we began to invite people to meetings for fellowship and Bible study and were surprised when they started attending. They were not deterred by the cold, lack of electricity or sirens. Most said that these meetings were a place where they experienced peace of mind, safety and hope. Amidst the myriad of losses—homes, loved ones, the hope of returning people discovered newfound faith and a transformed life in the Lord through their enduring suffering. God is always faithful, so we must be faithful in His calling.

TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

ETHNOS MISSIONS TRAINING (EMT)

The EMT is a **transformative ten-week training course** dedicated to equipping and mobilizing students. Our curriculum, taught by passionate and experienced leaders in global ministry, concentrates on fostering a disciple-making journey. Participants will dive into cross-cultural missions, study world religions, engage in evangelism and actively partake in outreaches within South Africa.

The EMT takes place on the beautiful **Carmel Coastal Retreat** located outside of George, Western Cape. Here, amidst diverse cultures and nations, students learn how to serve one another while navigating life collectively. Carmel's setting encourages reflection, allowing students to process their experiences together or seek quiet moments with views of the breathtaking ocean and nearby mountain ranges.

Throughout the EMT course, students actively **participate in a variety of outreach programs** such as hospital visits, street ministry, children's programs, and more. The course concludes with a week-long outreach where participants put into practice the knowledge and skills acquired during the program.

TRAINING GROUND GAP YEAR

Training Ground is a 10-month gap year program designed to expose young adults to real-life, hands-on ministry, as well as equip them with the necessary skills for living as intentional disciples of Jesus. Training Ground focuses on young adults, ages 18-24, who are wanting to explore their calling and future.

FOCAL POINT INTERNSHIP

Focal Point is a year-long media internship program designed to provide opportunities for individuals passionate about media and seeking to expand the Kingdom of God through their skills and creativity. Participants will grow in their faith, learn about missions, and further develop their videography, photography, and graphic design skills as they serve with Kollide Media and the Communications department.

NEXTGEN INTERNSHIP

The NextGen Internship focuses on discipleship, personal development, and exposure to children's ministry. Participants will learn how to work with, disciple, and share the gospel with underprivileged children from vulnerable communities. We use tools such as sports, dance, music, tutoring, and quality time to reach and disciple the children.







SHORT TERM OPPORTUNITIES

AFRICA MOVE is a six-week intercultural outreach that strives to inspire young adults from every nation for missions through discipleship and exposure. Our heart is for each student to encounter God and to ignite a passion within them to fulfill their role in the Great Commission.

Movers will have the opportunity to travel through South Africa as they serve and minister with experienced, cross-cultural missionaries. They will be involved in church planting, discipleship, mobilization, children's ministry, evangelism, practical work, and ministry amongst the vulnerable.





FOR FREEDOM is a week-long campaign dedicated to combating various forms of human trafficking. Our mission involves tackling issues such as slave labor, child soldiers, forced sex trade, and other oppressive facets.

We aim to raise awareness, gather funds for 15 projects, and offer practical support through activities like camps and construction projects. Participants can engage in freedom climbs, worship events, art awareness, evangelism, safe house construction, skills training, and morning prayer watches. Additionally, our campaign extends to addressing broader forms of oppression, including spiritual bondage and drug addiction.

MINISTRIES

CAPACITY MINISTRIES equip local churches and individuals through mobilization, recruitment, service, training, and financial development, empowering them to take ownership of the impact ministries.

IMPACT MINISTRIES involve pioneering and frontier efforts, with a focus on church planting and discipleship in communities that are least reached.

We see capacity ministries as the bow and impact ministries as the arrow that hits the target. **This is what we do:**

EMPOWERING WOMEN

AZARIA means "God has helped". Azaria strives to give skills to disadvantaged women to empower them to be who God created them to be. Our vision is to give women the opportunity to find freedom and the dignity to support their families through the making and selling of handmade materials, such as jewelry and machine-sewn products. These products are sold under the trade name "Wild Mongoo".

RUTH MINISTRIES aims to disciple women to grow in their relationship with God, and know their value in Christ so that they can fulfill God's purpose for their lives and advance His Kingdom in their families and communities.

HOLISTIC HEALTH CARE

DOOR OF HOPE is a medical project that aims to bring hope through holistic health care. We provide a Care Center specifically for women, children, and deaf families where we offer medical care, nutritional aid, health education, and counseling.

ETHNOS FAMILY EVENTS

Ethnos desires to see families healthy and whole, thriving in their marriages and raising their children according to biblical principles, all while living purposefully for His glory. To see this vision come to life, we host a variety of events throughout the year.

P.A.U.S.E. RETREATS are one-day retreats that aim to restore and refresh individuals through silence, solitude, and creative workshops.

TABLE TALKS are shorter events that aim to foster physical, emotional and spiritual well-being and wholeness through relevant topics, creative pursuits and inspirational speakers.

CHURCH PLANTING

THE WELL is a multicultural church, following the Great Commission to see God's Kingdom established. We not only focus on reaching the lost, but also equip the body of Christ for their service to the community by using the church as a training ground. Our current focus is on the vulnerable, as we reach out to the deaf community and children in the informal settlements.

SKILLS TRAINING

THE TABLE is a coffee shop located in George, Western Cape. Our aim is not only to have an impact in the local community, but also to help equip future missionaries practically and financially. We offer foundational skills training to those interested in becoming a barista or chef.

NINA GREGOIRE HAIR STUDIO

is a local hair salon ministry located in Durban, KwaZulu-Natal. It offers the opportunity to actively connect with the community, not only providing opportunities for skills training but also creating a consistent platform for evangelism and prayer in the heart of the neighborhood.

TRANSFORMING COMMUNITIES

LOVE LOOKS LIKE SOMETHING is a hands-on ministry to the vulnerable children, elderly and animals in Golden Valley, a township of George in the Western Cape. Our aim is not only to meet physical needs, but to see holistic transformation in people's lives and in the community of Golden Valley.

MOBILIZE

The **REACH CONFERENCE** is tailored for Christian leaders, pastors, influencers, and missionaries. It exists to share knowledge, develop ministry tools, and provide opportunities to help those who are called to align their passions and giftings for the Kingdom of God. Through various workshops, sessions, and seminars, participants can hear up-to-date information on various mission fields, learn about ministry opportunities, and discover how to get involved.

INVESTING IN THE NEXT GENERATION

CONNECT is a ministry that aims to connect young adults to each other, to God, and to their God given purpose. There are events taking place every second week, offering opportunities to get involved and build relationships with others.

GRACE KIDS is a day-care facility operating in the George inner-city catering for children as young as 10 months old up to age 5. Our aim is to develop children holistically, developing each child's unique God-given potential so that they may transition into the next phase of their lives with confidence. We provide a safe place for children by creating a caring, loving, nurturing and learning environment where children can participate in a wide range of experiences and develop their full potential.

NEXTGEN MINISTRY focuses on working with children from the informal settlements of George. Using tools such as dance, music, tutoring, sports, etc, our desire is to impact the 'next generation' holistically and to see them rise up as leaders in their communities.

ARISE MISSIONS MOVEMENT exists

to introduces young adults to crosscultural missions and ignites a passion for intentionally taking part in the Great Commission through camps and conferences. Our goal is to connect them with organizations and resources that would help them to facilitate this process further and encourage them to take practical steps toward their calling.
